

Ashley Valley Farmers Market
2020 Guidelines for Green/New Normal Phase
Updated June 22, 2020

- Everyone is encouraged to use sanitizer regularly.
- Booths must be 10' apart.
- Everyone is encouraged to practice social/physical distancing of 6' ft apart, reminders will be established on the sidewalks with cones. Everyone is encouraged to wear a face covering, especially when 6' ft distancing is not possible
- Vendors are encouraged to use "tap" or touchless payment options when possible (please see [USU's best practices farmers market guide](#) for more information on options).
- Vendors are strongly encouraged to sanitize point-of-sale equipment between transactions. Please refer to [CDC guidelines](#) on cleaning equipment and spaces.
- Food sampling **is allowed if samples are pre-packaged and not processed before** the market.
- Vendors are encouraged to handle produce and other goods instead of letting customers touch produce.
- Vendors are encouraged to offer pre-ordering.
- Vendors who do sell pre-package products **are required to be registered with the Utah Department of Agriculture** and display their company's current Food Establishment Permit at their booth. For questions regarding these recommendations, please contact Travis Waller at twaller@utah.gov
- Refund policy: Vendors not able to participate in the market due to Covid-19 restrictions or a market closure will receive a refund for the weeks impacted. Refunds will be issued by the Chamber of Commerce in a timely manner.
- As the Covid-19 pandemic is a fluid situation, the market will communicate any changes regarding these guidelines regularly with vendors **via email and Facebook**. The market will also communicate any changes that occur less than 48 hrs before the market via Facebook, phone or text when possible.
